**1. Jurisdiction**

This event is a Public Track Day held under a ClubSport Basic permit, promoted by the Southland Sports Car Club at Teretonga Park, Invercargill. It will be run in accordance with the Motorsport New Zealand National Sporting Code, Appendix 5 Sch C and Sch DR and these Supplementary Regulations.

The Motorsport New Zealand Permit Number is TBA.

**3. Entry Closing Date**

Enter on the day. The entry fee is \$70 per driver.

Acceptance of entry will be at the Clerk of the Course's discretion. Event organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

**4. Driver Requirements**

Driver must have -

- A current New Zealand Drivers Licence.
- Signed Parental Consent if under the age of 18 years.
- An approved crash helmet.
- Clean, protective one piece fire-retardant or pure cotton fabric overalls and footwear that completely cover the feet must be worn.

All Drivers must attend the Drivers Briefing.

**5. Vehicle Requirements**

- Vehicles shall either –
  - a. be to a warrantable standard; or
  - b. have a Motorsport New Zealand Vehicle Log Book.
- Noise limit 95dba.
- No passengers to be carried except at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
