

## SSCC Bent Sprint 2021 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a sealed Bent Sprint organised and promoted by the Southland Sports Car Club. It will run under a ClubSport Advanced permit and will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

### 3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

- 3.1** The course will be set by officials on the day of the event but will comprise of a combination of the circuit, pit sections and infield roading and will be an approximate length of between 2 and 3km. The set course will be a balance of high-speed and technical sections.

- 3.2** **Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (1)** 0-1600cc
- (2)** 1601-2500cc
- (3)** 2501cc and over

**Note:** Multiply the cubic capacity of turbo engines by 1.7, and rotary engines by 1.8.

### 4. ENTRIES:

- 4.1** Entries must be submitted using the entry form attached to these supplementary regulations along with the entry fee up until 5.00pm on the Thursday before the event.  
Entries on the day may be accepted but will incur a late fee of \$20.  
Acceptance of on the day entries will be subject to competitor numbers. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry. This will only be exercised in exceptional circumstances or if entry exceeds 50 competitors.

**4.4 Opening and Closing Dates:**

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close 5pm on 29 April 2021.

**4.5 Entry Fees:**

The Entry fee for this event is \$70, including GST per competitor.  
The late entry fee for this event is \$90, including GST per competitor.

**4.6 Number of Starters:** The maximum number of starters will be 50. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

**5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:**

**5.1 Licence Requirements:**

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

**5.2 Competitor Understanding:**

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.

**5.3** All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

**5.4 Drivers' Briefing:**

This will be held at the start line commencing at 10.45am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend may result in a penalty.

**6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES**

**6.1 Compliance:** All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

**6.2 Tyres:** It is permitted to use tyre types as defined in the current Motorsport New Zealand Manual, Part One Article 2 of Schedule A, they are classified as follows:

- (i) Road Tyre, or
- (ii) Treaded Tyre, or
- (iii) Slick Tyre, or (iv) Wet Tyre.

## **7. DUAL ENTRY**

**7.1** A maximum of three (3) drivers may share a vehicle. This must be indicated on the entry form to ensure organisers can manage the running order.

## **8. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION**

**8.1 Documentation:** Will take place at Pit Office commencing at 9.30am and concluding at 10.30am. Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licenses, logbook and documents for issuing of competition numbers prior to presenting the car for audit scrutineering.

**8.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:** Will take place at Turntru Machining Scrutineering Shed commencing at 9.30am and concluding at 10.30am. You should assume that your vehicle is going to be subjected to an audit and as a consequence is in readiness to be taken to the audit venue immediately after you have completed documentation.

## **9. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:**

**9.1** Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 15 entries are received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.

## **10. OFFICIAL BULLETINS**

**10.1** Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

## **11. GENERAL INFORMATION**

**11.1 Passengers:** May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.

**11.2** Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

**11.3** No smoking allowed in Pit Paddock.

**11.4** Animals are not permitted within confines of the grounds with this event.

### **11.5 Programme:**

Gates Open 8.30am.

Documentation & Scrutineering 9.30 -1030am.

Drivers Briefing & Roll Call 10.45am

The Indian-file run will commence at 11.00am with timed runs commencing immediately following.

There will be between 3 and 5 timed qualifying runs depending on time available. No allowances will be made for the weather.

At the completion of qualifying runs there will be a top ten shootout. All competitors qualifying for the top ten shootout will have their previous times discarded.
