

Autocross Championship 2025-2026 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. JURISDICTION

These events are ClubSport Basic Status Events, promoted by the Southland Sports Car Club at Teretonga Park, Invercargill. It will be run in accordance with the Motorsport New Zealand National Sporting Code, Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Sch A in the current MotorSport New Zealand Manual, and these Supplementary Regulations.

2. MAJOR OFFICIALS:

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1** Entries can be completed online via the MSNZ App. Payment must be made at the time of entry. Closing date is 12.00noon on the Friday before the event.
- 3.2** Entries will be accepted on the day of the event by filling out the appropriate entry form and making payment by either cash or eftpos.
- 3.3** Entry fees –
- Online Entries \$65 per competitor
 - On the day \$75 per competitor
- 3.4** Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4. EVENT DESCRIPTION

- 4.1** The event will be run on the sealed surfaces at Teretonga Park. Two Courses will be run using the circuit proper and adjacent lanes. Courses will be notified on the day.
- 4.2** The event will be divided into the following classes:
- 1601cc & Over
 - 0-1600cc

5. NUMBER OF STARTERS

The maximum number of starters will be 60. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

6. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING

6.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold a current club membership of a MSNZ affiliated Member Club except for new competitors to motorsport, who may compete in two (2) Basic Status Events before being required to join a club.

6.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitor obligations, and
- Appendix 5, Schedule C.

6.3 To be eligible for the SSCC Autocross Championship, competitors must be a full member of the Southland Sports Car Club.

6.4 All Drivers must attend the Drivers Briefing which will be held prior to the event start.

6.5 Drivers should have as a minimum a current New Zealand Drivers Licence.

6.6 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

6.7 Any driver between the ages of 12-16 years of age, who does not hold a valid MotorSport NZ competition licence, may be allowed to compete on the following conditions –

- That the venue restrictions along with the vehicle type and cubic capacity restrictions detailed in Appendix One Schedule L Article 3.2(2) are respected; and
- An underage indemnity form has been completed correctly by Parent/Guardian; and
- Only at the discretion of the event Clerk of the Course.

6.8 Drivers intending to take passengers must complete a Driver Indemnity form at documentation.

7. PASSENGER REQUIREMENTS

7.1 Passengers may be carried at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course provided that Article 6 of Appendix 5 Schedule C in the current MotorSport New Zealand manual is adhered to.

7.2 The minimum age of passengers is 12 and they must have completed an Underage Indemnity Form.

7.3 Passenger Indemnity Form must be completed prior to entering the vehicle.

8. VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

8.1 All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current Motorsport New Zealand Manual.

8.2 Vehicles shall either –

- a. be to a warrantable standard; or
- b. have a Motorsport New Zealand Vehicle Log Book.

8.3 Electric vehicles may be accepted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course providing they have the appropriate certification/logbook from MotorSport NZ.

8.4 Noise limit 95dba.

9. CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS AS PER SCHEDULE A

9.1 An approved crash helmet.

9.2 Clean, protective one piece fire-retardant or 100% cotton fabric overalls and leather footwear that completely cover the feet.

9.3 Undergarments must be either cotton or wool.

10. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

10.1 Documentation will take place in the Documentation Office at Teretonga Park commencing at 9.00am and concluding at 10.00am.

10.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection will take place in conjunction with Documentation so reporting times are as above and will be held in the Scrutineering Shed.

11. FUEL HANDLING AND STORAGE

Fuel storage and handling shall be the competitor's responsibility. Competitors are reminded that they are required to be familiar with the MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel – Storage and Handling.

12. SCHEDULE

13. FORCE MAJEURE

If due to Force Majeure, the required number of runs cannot be completed, the Clerk of the Course has the authority to reduce the number of runs counting toward the result.
